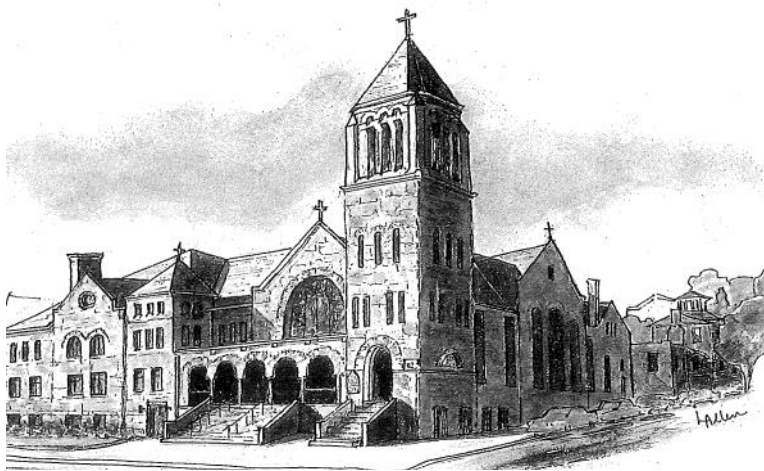

- 3 Small Hand Sanitizer Bottles (with pump)



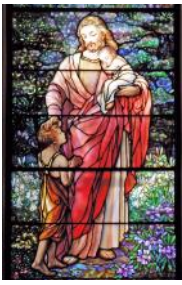
Glass Recycling
