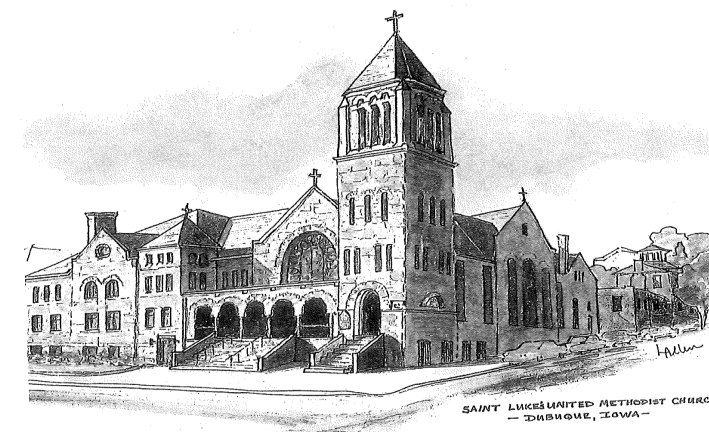

Don't forget the Summer Organ Concert series every Wednesday (June through August) at the Sinsinawa Mound Center's Our Lady of the Rosary Chapel at 7:00 p.m. Admission is free. This week's concert features David Jonies.

David resides in Chicago and is the associate director of music and organist at Holy Name Cathedral, Chicago, where he plays the four-manual Flentrop organ, one of the largest tracker-action instruments in the country.

He also directs the Holy Name Cathedral Summer Organ Series. A native of Germany, Jonies has studied at Metten Abbey, Bavaria, Germany; Hochschule für Musik Würzburg (University of Music, Würzburg, Germany); and the Royal Academy of Music, London, England. His teachers include Gerhard Weinberger, Günther Kaunzinger, David Titterington, and James O'Donnell.
