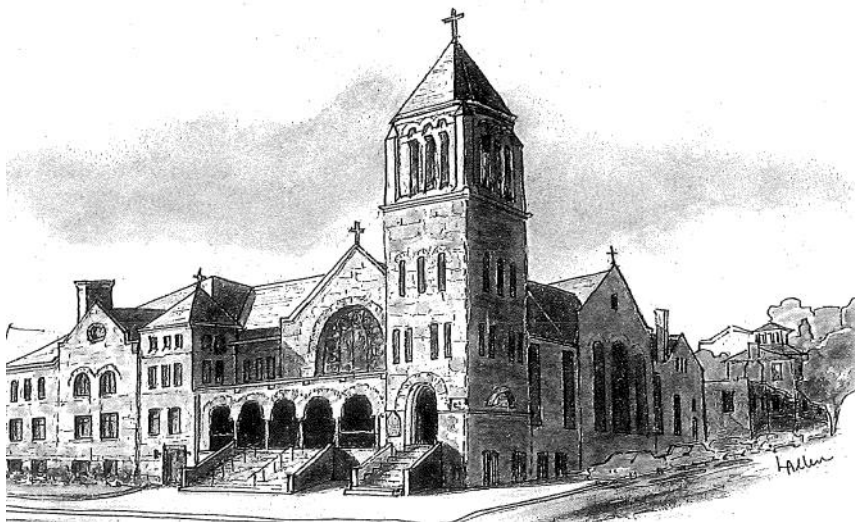

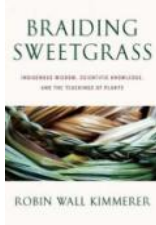

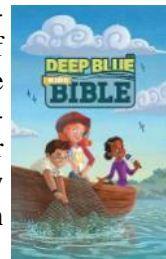

## St. Mark Youth Enrichment

**87 students** were impacted by the 7 week summer learning program hosted by St. Mark Youth Enrichment with which some of our St. Luke's family was involved. 43% of students identify as racial minority and 70% receive free or reduced lunch. 81% maintained or increased their literacy skills over the summer (14% increased) compared to the two months of skill level normally lost over the course of an average summer. **Thank you!**
