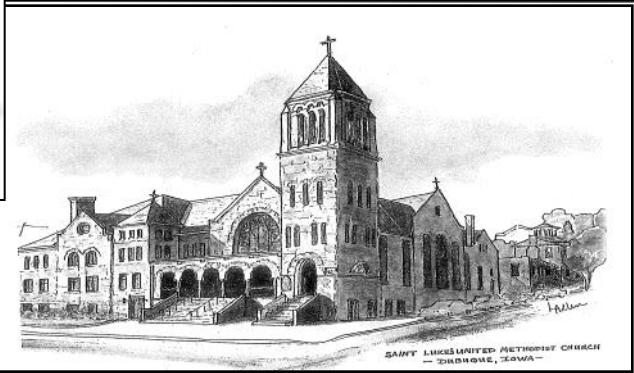

## Chuck's Chat — May 29, 2019

I'm reading a little book by Anne Lamott called *Help Thanks Wow: The Three Essential Prayers*. (I've only gotten through the *Help* section so far.) This is a very down-to-earth book. Near the end of the first section, Lamott shares a prayer that she has written. She writes:

Hi, God.

I am just a mess.

It is all hopeless.

What else is new?

I would be sick of me, if I were You, but miraculously You are not.

I know I have no control over other people's lives and I hate this. Yet I believe that if I accept this and surrender, You will meet me wherever I am.

Wow. Can this be true? If so, how is this afternoon—say, two-ish?

Thank You in advance for Your company and blessings. You have never once let me down.

Amen.

This might look a bit flippant for addressing God. But in fact, it is a very powerful prayer. First, it has Lamott's three essentials: "Help – Wow – Thanks." Second, it acknowledges our messiness, our weakness and lack of control. Third, it doesn't try to manipulate God, but it also doesn't underestimate the possibility of God "showing up."

Friends, I invite you to pray just this concretely when you talk to God. It does little good to pretend with God. It does a great deal to be real with God. We cannot shock God. We cannot deceive God. We cannot outrun God's love for us.
