## Green Team Bags

St. Luke's Green Team is a member of the Dubuque Chapter of Iowa Interfaith Power & Light, whose mission is to equip people of faith to address climate disruption and related environmental impacts with a social justice theology. Interfaith Power & Light (IPL) began in 1998 and now has 40 state affiliates.

The Dubuque campaign's reusable bags were purchased from a local Dubuque printer and printed with non-toxic ink. Bags advertise Iowa Interfaith Power & Light and all the participating congregations. As the bags were paid for in part by a grant of Sustainable Dubuque, 20% of the reusable bags are going to the Dubuque Rescue Mission stores & Dubuque Farmers Market SNAP customers to engage the local community beyond participating faith groups.

St. Luke's has received 80 bags. Half of these are being given out as part of the food ministry. Green Teams members will be tabling before and after services from Sunday 3 September until the bags are gone to hand out the other 40.

We are asking for donations of \$4-6 for these bags to offset the ones being distributed for free through the food ministry. If you have any questions, contact Social Justice Co-Chairs RRS & Terry Stewart or Mary Thomas Armstrong, who is facilitator for the Dubuque IPL Chapter.

In 2016, Dubuque Crop Walk raised \$15,562.02

We deeply appreciate the 25 St Lukers who contributed so that we gave over \$600. You're a critical member of the CROP Hunger Walk family. Thank you. Your donations brings new life to your community... and it definitely brings new life to communities in need around the world!

Of the total earnings, 25% go to fight hunger and poverty locally at DACU's People in Need, the Dubuque Food Pantry, and the Dubuque Rescue Mission. The remaining 75% will go to fight hunger and poverty globally. This past spring, CROP Hunger Walk funds provided rainwater tanks for a rural village in Myanmar. It now means clean water for nearly 600 people.

The 2017 Dubuque CROP Walk will be held on Sunday, October 1, starting at Holy Trinity Lutheran. The route will be as last year, walk to Murphy Park and back to HTLC, about 4 miles. Teams are invited to show up at HTLC for lunch at noon. Registration and pictures will start at 12:30 pm, with the walk beginning at 1:00pm.

This year teams are asked to where their favorite sports memorabilia in honor longtime Crop Walk Organizer Maryann Caudill LoGuidice, the Ultimate Sports Fan.
