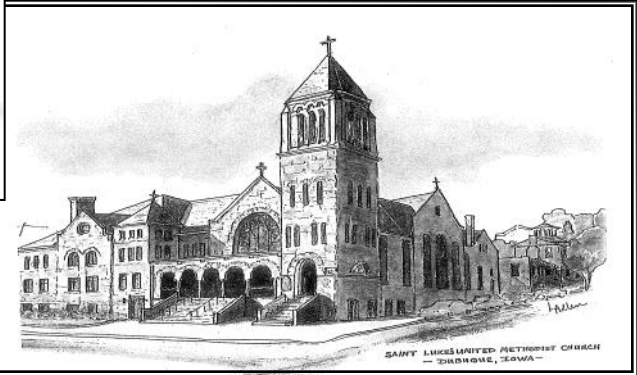

## A Word from the Pastor

Dear Church,

We have a fun group of students participating in our confirmation process. I love teaching confirmation as it gives me a chance to get to have weekly time with our church's teenagers. Last week, after reenacting the experiences of some of the early Methodist circuit riders (and laughing a LOT), Emmy and I were able to surprise the class with a gift.



Laurinda Brimeyer ("Mrs. B" to the students), asked us to gift each confirmation student their own Youth Study Bible, engraved with their names. This gift was funded by memorial funds in honor of Laurinda's mother. Before presenting the Bibles to the students, I said:

*"Do you all know that Mrs. B loves you?"*

With ear to ear grins, they replied, "YES!"

*"And do you know that she loves God's Story / The Bible?"*

Again with smiles, they said, "We do."

*"She loves you, and she loves sharing God's story with you, and so she wanted you to have these gifts: Bibles with your names engraved on them."*

For the first time that evening, there was a stunned silence. The students looked in awe at the Bibles, amazed at "how fancy" they are, and they began to thumb through the pages. It was a poignant moment. I will always remember that brief silence as a Holy Spirit moment. What a difference it makes to share our love of God and our love for each other. I hope we all make a little more of an effort to show our love of God and neighbor this week.

Use the sign up clipboard in the south hall (with red and green ribbon) and add you name and information.

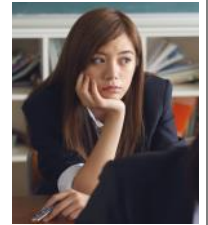
Please bring hams to church by **December 11, 2019.**
